SPOT Contest Report by George Gilbert, CD

Turn out was better than I had anticipated, with 27 entries total. Friday saw mostly the Pro P-30 and Vintage FAI events.

There were a few flights in other events, but with the adjacent FAI Contest and the Vintage FAI flying, not a lot happening. See the Vintage and P-30 event reports.

Saturday gave way to a bit more wind than Friday and the rising air was tricky to find and stay in the smaller thermals. Due to a wind shift on Sunday, the trailer was moved to the south end of the field after the scale flying was completed. Not as many scale entries this time out. The wind held back some flying but after mid morning the wind dropped down and the flying started to really happen. All told it was a good contest and enjoyed by all.

Vintage Power and Pro P-30 Report by Bob Stalick

Vintage FAI Power and Pro P-30 were both flown on Friday. Early wind direction was from the South and we discussed the possibility of delaying the first round for a bit, and then as if by magic, the wind shifted in time for the 8:30 am start. Since it was reasonably calm, we started with the three minute flights in round one., and everyone maxed except Dave Ives in P-30. Second round was also set for 3 minutes, and this time Stalick dropped the round. Round 3 was kept at 3 minutes, even though the wind had begun to pick up.Swift, Stalick, Dona, and Tarvin (V-4) dropped Nigel entered 2 models in different eras, and his Uranus was not quite ready for prime time, as he had had numerous issues with the DT system. Decker was also unable to put in a flight as his trusty Maxamatic Hawk had developed a fuelline issue, and he was unable to continue. Meanwhile, the

P-30 boys were hitting all the good air, except for Glenn Grell, who dropped 5 seconds... Round 4 was flown at 2 minutes. All the power guys maxed, but Dona, who was also unable to continue. Round 5 saw all the remaining fliers max, except for Robert Hauk in P-30.

The flyoffs began and it was over quickly in P-30, as neither Koran or Vernon maxed, but Vernon did a bit better to pull out the win. In power, it became a marathon of flyoff flights with Hannah putting in 6 flyoff maxes to seal the win.

The clouds broke around 11:00 and the air was really good from around Noon until 2:00. Many flyers were able to take advantage of it, but then the wind returned with a vengeance.

Sunday morning was calm, clear and cold at sunrise, but the wind returned after a couple of hours. Scale flights were started at 7:45 AM and were completed in 30 minutes--plenty of time to allow the first round of Vintage Power to start at 8:30. Flying conditions improved in the afternoon and there was a lot of flying. At the awards ceremony Bruce Hannah and Glenn Grell presented the plaques for Vintage FAI Power, Vintage Wakefield, Spirit of Nostalgia, and E-20. One really bright spot on Sunday was Sara Menanno winning A Gas. Watch out guys, which event will she try next?

Commentary

The Vintage FAI and Pro P-30 Events were scheduled for friday at 8:30 am, but field conditions were such that the event was postponed for an hour so the rains would subside and visibility would improve. Then another 30 minute delay was instituted and a final meeting of the contestants was called at 11 am. After discussion, it was decided to postpone both events until Sunday when the prediction was for excellent weather.

At 8:30 am Sunday, after the scale flying was completed, the first round, set for one hour, commenced. Of the 16 entrants, ten were able to put in official flights, with 8 maxes recorded in Vintage. Since there were only two entrants in Pro P=30, both contestants set up their own rounds system on Friday.

As the day progressed, the variable winds of the early morning began to settle in for the normal drift to the south, and the sun came out and warmed up everyone, producing nice light thermals. The chase for the Buskell cup was an interesting sidelight to this meet, as three contestants, who had scored well in August, had a shot at it. Schneider, Pope and Hannah. As it turned out, Hannah was able to nab it, as both Schneider and Pope dropped a round and ended with identical scores.

The decision to shorten rounds 2-5 to 45 minutes each added pressure to the competition. Finally, when it was time for the flyoiffs, the decision was to institute 5 minute flyoff window, which all of the contestants remaining handled with ease--something to consider in the future!


E-20 Award- winner for 2023 - Bob Nelson
